

2011-2012 Adult Competition Report –Angel Hall

2012 Indiana Adult State Cup

The 2011 Adult State Cup finals were played at the same venue and blended in with the youth state finals event. The event was hosted at Lawrence Park in Indianapolis. The FC Indiana team earned the State Cup Champion title for the 2012 Men's Open Division. The Indiana Tournament and Cup Committee now facilitate the hosting of the adult games.

2012 Region II Tournament of Champions

The 2012 Tournament of Champions featured the previous champions along with current state and league championship teams in four competitive categories from the Midwest Region's 14 state associations. These categories include Men's Open, Men 0/30, Men U23, and Women's Open. No Indiana teams succeeded in securing a Championship title. This year the event was held at the Fort Wayne Sport Club in Fort Wayne, Indiana, and was hosted jointly by the Club and Indiana Soccer.

2012 USASA National Cup Regionals

The 2012 USASA National Cup Regional event was held in Fort Wayne and was jointly hosted by the Fort Wayne Sport Club and Indiana Soccer. Approximately 30 men's and women's teams attended.

2012 Adult Competitive Leagues

Indiana has hosted as many as thirteen different competitive adult men's and women's leagues in the past. In 2012, twelve leagues (up from 9 in 2011) were active and registering players with the state association. Since the Adult competitive year is January through December, the existing leagues continue registering players on this calendar cycle.
