

## **2011-2012 League Task Force Report – Angel Hall, Chairman**

During 2011-2012, the Indiana Soccer League Task Force continued to remain in contact through e-mail for day to day activities.

December 2011, the LTF met to discuss and work through the possibilities of merging all leagues in to one state league (ISL). All leagues were represented at the meeting and agreed it would best serve the membership to have a single league with a single entry point for every team. This merge would simplify the league structure process for the members.

March 2012, it was decided that all leagues would merge. GIRLS, CIYSL, EASA, and NISL all agreed to complete the spring 2012 season under separate league structure, and beginning the fall of 2012, only one league (ISL) would serve the membership. Indiana Soccer requested that the current board members from the existing leagues remain as volunteers to assist ISL in the transition.

During this same time period, ICL (Indiana Champions League) chose not to join all the rest of the leagues and withdrew its membership from Indiana Soccer effective July 2012.

GIRLS, CIYSL, EASA, and NISL are all in the process of managing the reconstruction or dissolution of their entities and no longer serve Indiana Soccer members in managing travel league play. GIRLS agreed to dissolve the corporation and to transfer all remaining assets to the Indiana Soccer Foundation in the form of a restricted donation.

July 2012, the LTF officially disbanded as a committee.
