Note: This year, 19U players will not be able to play in the 18U divisions. As before, based on the team registrations, ISL may combine age groups and/or levels (2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>) to create play groups.

**Fall Players – 2004 and older (for ISL ONLY, these options do not apply to NL: MWC/GLC or Cup play):**

There are three options for these players:

- A 2004 player may play as a trapped player on a 2005 team in the fall only. Maximum of three 2004 players may participate in any one game. You may have as many 2004 players rostered as you like.
- 15U 11v11 – for 2004 players who are not playing high school soccer. There is only one play division at this time. At no time during the season is a 2004 player who played high school soccer this fall allowed to play on this team. 2005 and 2006 players may play on this team.
- 15&Over 7v7 – for 2004 and older players who are not playing high school soccer. There is only one play division at this time. At no time during the season is a 2004 player who played high school soccer this fall allowed to play on this team.
