### Spring 2016

- Premier & 1<sup>st</sup> Divisions at U13, U14, U15, U16, U17 and U18\*, Boys and Girls
- 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Divisions at U13, U14, U15, U16, U17 and U18\*, Boys and Girls
  - \*We allow an unlimited of U19s play on U18 teams.
- 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Divisions at U11 and U12, Boys and Girls
- U10 Division (which include U9 & U8) are divided into Level 1, Level 2, Level 3 & Level 4 based on ability and somewhat age.
- U10-ISA are two groups that are registered with Indiana Soccer Association but organize themselves independently.

### Looking forward to Fall 2016 and Spring 2017

The new age group and small sided games mandates will be implemented. In respect to the age groups, clubs will have the options to a) create new teams based on their birth years or b) keep their existing teams together and age some of the players up.

Beginning this fall, we will work to organize 15 and under and 16 and over 7v7 or 8v8 Divisions to provide opportunities for those players who are not or cannot participate in high school soccer.
