Indiana Soccer now coordinates two Select Leagues (ECIYSL & NESSL) and support the efforts of Carmel FC, ZYSA and USAi in the coordination of their Select League, NWMC.

We introduced sending out schedules approximately 48 hours prior to the scheduling meeting and this has been received warmly. It allows clubs to review conflicts ahead of time, making the actual scheduling meeting an easier process.

The new divisions of 15U 11v11 and 15 & Over 7v7 for fall play has been a success. This is fulfilling a need for players who want to play in the fall.

The policy of restricting coaches who move from Club A to Club B was put into place beginning this year.

#### Looking forward to the Fall of 2018 and Spring of 2019:

At the 2018 AGM, we will be discussing the following:

- Extend the no intentional heading rule to include 12U games, this would make no intentional heading in all small sided games (4v4, 7v7, 9v9).
- We will present a more black and white promotion/relegation policy for teams moving from ISL 1<sup>st</sup> to ISL Premier Divisions, ISL Premier to MRL and the relegation of teams from MRL 1<sup>st</sup> Division to ISL Premier.
- We will be discussing a more black and white seeding process for State and Presidents Cups.
