

2012-2013 Indiana Soccer League Report – George Perry, ISL Commissioner

The Indiana Soccer League (ISL) expanded to include the Regional leagues (GIRLS, CIYSL, EASA, and NISL). ISL Commissioner, George Perry and ISL Administrator Angel Hall oversaw the expansion of ISL play with the support of Administrative Assistant Jennifer Austin and significant input from many of the clubs' Director of Coaching.

Fall 2012

- 15th ISL Season
- 567 teams in the U9 through U14 age groups in ISL play
- 10 teams competed in MRL play in the U13 and U14 age groups
- 2358 ISL games were scheduled

Spring 2013

- 16th ISL Season
- 920 teams in the U9 through U18 age groups in ISL play
- 69 teams competed in MRL play in the U13 – U18 age groups
- 3788 ISL games were scheduled

During the 2012-2013 year, ISL did not make any significant changes to the league procedures, rules or administration. However, in preparing for the 2013-2014 year, a DOC Advisory group will be formed to assist in league placement, and Cup seeding. Also, it is anticipated that the U9 and U10 age groups will be merged and a single U10 group formed with 4 levels of play within the one age group. This will provide flexibility in club placement of teams based on the player's development.

Due to the expansion of the number of teams and the increased schedule, two additional Administrative Assistants will be hired beginning the Fall of 2013.
