

## **LARRY ROWLAND**

Larry is the former President and CEO of Lincoln Re, which was the nation's largest life & health reinsurer. Lincoln Re was sold to Swiss Re in late 2001 for \$2 billion, at which time Larry became the President of Swiss Re Life & Health, North America. Swiss Re is the world's largest reinsurance company. In 2003, Larry joined NxtStar Ventures LLC, a venture catalyst firm providing advice and counsel to the financial services industry.

Larry has served as Board Chair for over 15 for profit companies throughout the world. He was a member of the senior management team at both Swiss Re and Lincoln National Corporation. He has also served as a Director for a number of insurance companies including, The Lincoln National Life Insurance Company, Lincoln National Life of New York, and First Penn-Pacific Life Insurance Company. He has served as a Director for ReMark, a transnational direct-marketing company headquartered in Amsterdam. Under Larry's leadership, Lincoln Re sales organically grew 583%, and the firm was consistently rated the best overall life & health reinsurer in the nation by an independent market research firm serving the life & health reinsurance industry.

Larry is active in the community and the state. Larry has served on the boards of the Lincoln Foundation, Fort Wayne YMCA, Fort Wayne Ballet, Fort Wayne Sports Corporation, Fort Wayne Philharmonic, and the Greater Fort Wayne Community Foundation.
