



Todd Sheely is currently in his 13th year with Indiana ODP and has worked with multiple ages and genders over that time period. Most recently he has served as the Assistant Director of Indiana ODP/ Player Development, a position he held for 3 years, and Sheely also serves as the Age Group Coordinator for the 2005/06 age group.

Coach Sheely starts his second year as the Director of Indiana ODP/ Player Development. Todd Sheely has been a high school coach for 15 years in the state of Indiana with 14 of those as a Head Coach. He was named the Indiana High School Girls Coach of the Year in 2007. He is currently the boys soccer Coach and Social Studies Teacher at Elkhart Memorial High School. He was named the Center Grove High School Teacher of the year in 2009.

Coach Sheely graduated from Center Grove in 1997 and IUPUI in 2001. He was a starter on the team that won conference at IUPUI and played in the first College Cup, or NCAA Tournament, in school history in 2000. He and his teammates were recently inducted into the IUPUI Hall of Fame. Todd has two sons Mayson (11) and Brennan (9). He holds a National Youth License and NSCAA Premier Diploma.
