



## IMPORTANT GAME DAY INFORMATION

### LEAGUE RULES

A complete set of ISL (Indiana Soccer League) rules is available online. It is important that you read and understand every rule.

### OFFICIAL GAME CARDS AND PLAYER PASSES/CARDS

#### 11U – 19/20U Games

Prior to ISL matches, each team must provide the following:

- ⚽ Two (2) copies of their Official ISL Game Card printed from your GotSport Team Account.
  - One (1) copy for the referee **AND** one (1) copy for your opponent.
  - Each player's name **MUST** be printed on the official game card by GotSport (not handwritten), or the player **MAY NOT** play.
  - Reasoning: Teams that print off their game cards closest to the game will have the most accurate game card.
- ⚽ Player passes/cards will be checked at the start of each game by the referee.
  - Player passes/cards, hard and/or virtual copies, must be shown. They are used to verify that the name on the player's pass/card matches the name on the game card.
  - After the players are checked in, the passes/cards are returned to the team. Referees do not need to keep them during the game.
- ⚽ Player passes/cards are not enough. The player's name **MUST** be printed on the game card.
- ⚽ Only Exception to the Above: The team presents a letter/email from the ISL Commissioner or Administrator approving player/team.

#### 15U 11v11 or 15 & Over 7v7 Games (Fall ONLY)

Prior to the ISL matches, each team must provide the following:

- ⚽ Same as above for 11U-19/20U Games.
- ⚽ In some cases, ISL allows players to come together from multiple clubs to form one team.
  - Each club will need to provide a State Roster and player cards from their club.
  - Referees would be checking in players from multiple clubs for one team.

#### 8U-10U Games

Prior to ISL matches, each team must provide **ONE (1)** of the following:

- ⚽ A State Roster Pool list with the players participating that day highlighted **or** checked.
- ⚽ A copy of the game card with the players' names typed on the card.
- ⚽ Player passes/cards, hard and/or virtual copies, may be used.

## REFEREE FEES

Each team must bring ½ of the fee in cash to the game in exact amounts for each referee (see table below). Referees are **NOT** required to make change.

- ⚽ Referees are paid prior to kick-off.
- ⚽ Teams only pay the referee(s) officiating the game. Teams keep fee(s) for the referee(s) that do not show.
- ⚽ If the game fails to start due to weather and cannot be played, the referees are **NOT** paid.
- ⚽ If the game kicks-off but is then delayed due to weather, the referees keep their fees (even if game cannot be restarted/completed).
- ⚽ It is US Soccer policy that a two-referee system is **NOT PERMITTED**. Club AR(s) must be used.

8U	4 x 10-min quarters <b>plus</b> 5 min between quarters
10U	25-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime
11U & 12U	30-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime
13U & 14U	35-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime
15U & 16U	40-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime
17U & above	45-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime
<b>Fall Only</b> – 15U (11v11) and 15 & Over (7v7)	35-min halves <b>plus</b> 10-min halftime

## SEND OFFS AND SUSPENSIONS

Team managers and coaches are expected to self-enforce all suspensions. On **ALL** ISL Send Offs and Expulsions/Suspensions, the player, coach, or team official must **NOT** participate in the team's next scheduled ISL game. A team that plays an ineligible player shall be subject to disciplinary action including, but not limited to forfeiture of the match, suspension of the team's coach from ISL competition, and/or expulsion of the team from the ISL.

## SEVERE WEATHER GAME CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS

All weather-related game information will be communicated via text message (must opt in on GotSport) and email to the team coach(es) and manager(s) as well as posted on the ISL website.

**NOTE: Only ISL can cancel games due to weather. Do NOT assume that a closed field means the game is cancelled. ISL will attempt to relocate a game BEFORE cancelling a game due to field closures. You will be notified either way if your team is affected.**

## GAME CHANGES AND/OR FORFEITS

After the final schedule is released, each game change request will incur a \$100 fee payable to Indiana Soccer. An invoice will be placed in the club's account and due immediately to the league. Any postponement/forfeit requested 2 days prior to game date (excluding game date) will incur additional fines including the full cost of the referee fees for that age group.
