### Indiana State Cup, Presidents Cup, Challenge Cup, and Memorial Cup

Full cup activity returned in 2021. A total of 575 teams participated in the State, Presidents, and Challenge Cup games.

The preliminary round games for State, Presidents, and Challege Cup events took place: May 14-16, 2021, in Westfield at Grand Park and in Columbus at Richard Wigh Soccer Complex. May 21-23, 2021, in Westfield at Grand Park.
