2021 brought us back to an attainable level of competition. The Region II Tournament of Champions was held in Iowa. Indiana had one representative in spite of the deterrents related to the distance and fuel costs associated with the Iowa location.

USASA's September Annual General Meeting was held virtually due to Covid 19 precautions. Richard Groff was elected Vice President. Governance was the main area of discussion in a meeting lasting less than three hours.

NWIOBFC, FWASL, CIASA, CIWSL and Cultural Rise were back in full competition. Participation numbers are down from the highest level of participation but increasing over the previous year.
