Indiana State Cup, Presidents Cup, Challenge Cup, and Memorial Cup

A total of 555 teams participated in the State, Presidents, and Challenge Cup games.

- The preliminary round games for State, Presidents, and Challenge Cup events took place:
May 13-15, 2022, in Westfield at Grand Park.
May 20-22, 2022, in Westfield at Grand Park.
- The finals for State, Presidents, and Challenge Cup were held:
June 4-5, 2022, in Westfield at Grand Park

The Indiana Memorial Cup hosted 155 teams and was held June 4-5, 2022, in Westfield, Indiana at Grand Park in conjunction with the cup finals.

2022 US Youth Soccer National Championships and National Presidents Cup

The NCS Midwest Regional event was held June 24-29, 2022, at Grand Park in Westfield and was hosted by Indiana Soccer. Approximately 220 teams participated. Indiana entered all 14 of its state cup champions and several wildcard teams to fill vacancies. One team advanced to the national event after participating in an additional league playoff game held during regionals - the Elkhart Flames ECU 2005B Maroon team.

The Midwest Region President Cup event was held June 10-14, 2020, in St. Louis, Missouri. Indiana entered the U13-U19 state presidents cup champions (14 teams). Two of the Indiana teams advanced out of regionals to play in the National Presidents Cup event: Columbus Express 2008B Orange and Elkhart Flames ECU 2004B Maroon. Please join me in congratulating the ECU 2004B Maroon team who won the U18 boy's national event.
