These age groups will progress to Regional and National Championships.

ISL 2005/04 teams may participate in State and Presidents Cups for this 2023-2024 year, but they will have to **remove their 2004 players** from their State and Presidents Cup roster.

Fall Players – 2009 and older (for ISL ONLY, these options do not apply to NL – GLC/MWC or Cup play) There are three options for these players:

- A 2009 player may play as a “trapped” player on a 2010 team in the fall only. A maximum of three 2009 players may participate in any one game. You may roster as many 2009 players as you like. If a team is using a “trapped” player(s), that team is not eligible for promotion for the next season.
- 15U 11v11 – for 2009 players who are not playing high school soccer. There is currently only one play division. If a club has a 15U 11v11 team, that club may not use a 2009 player as a “trapped player on a 2010 team.
- 15 & Over 7v7 – for 2009 and older players who are not playing high school soccer. There is currently only one play division.
- At no time is a player who participated in high school soccer eligible to play in the fall ISL season.
