Indiana Soccer competitive landscape consists of the following:

- USYS (US Youth Soccer) E64 & E64 RL (Regional League) Both are a club vs club-based competition. Clubs must attain a high level of competitiveness to participate.
- USYS GLC/MWC Great Lakes Conference/Midwest Conference two of 13 USYS conferences with two levels, Premier I and Premier II. Teams are selected based on their performance in ISL Premier.
- ISL Indiana Soccer League Statewide League with 2nd, 3rd, 4th divisions for 11 & 12U teams and Premier, 1st, 2nd 3rd divisions for 13U-19U teams.
- ISA CNC, Indiana Soccer Association Central North Conference 8U-10U Indianapolis area play group, administrated by an ISL appointed administrator.
- ECIYSL East Central Indiana Youth Soccer League (a select or Rec+ league administrated by ISL Commissioner)
- NESSL Northeast Select Soccer League (a select or Rec+ league administrated by ISL Commissioner)

The Small-Sided Referee Course is still being utilized and we are slowing beginning to grow the numbers in our referee pool. There is also still good registration for the Guardian of the Game (Club AR) program to help when a referee does not show up or cannot be found for a game.
