CLUB TECHNICAL LEADERSHIP (CTL)





USP CTL Level 1

{Previously termed the DOC License}

- Hold a U.S. Soccer B license for at least 6 months
- Have a minimum of one (1) year experience in a club technical leadership role (DOC, Technical Director, Age Group/Gender DOC, GK DOC)
- A waiver of the U.S. Soccer B License may be considered based on foreign licensure and/or 10 years
 of club technical leadership experience.

AND

- Applicants must be currently serving in a technical leadership role within a club responsible in full or in part for:
 - -Club player development philosophy
 - -Club player development plan or age group development plan
 - -Club coach development plan or age group coach development plan

Waiver forms can be found in the CTL Resoucesfolder on Box. Completed waivers should be emailed to smcmillan@ussoccer.org

• Work in a youth club /academy as a club technical leader

AND

Hold a CTL Level 1(formerly DOC) for at least 1year

<u>OR</u>

- Hold a valid USSF A license for at least 2 years and work as a club technical leader for at least five (5)
 years
- A waiver of the U.S. Soccer A License may be considered if an applicant holds a recognized equivalent foreign license.



CTL level 2 Application Review

Applicants will be evaluated on:

- √ Club technical leadership experience
- √ Coaching experience
- √ Professional Playing experience
- √ Educational background
- √ Continuous education (CPD)

COURSE UPDATES





Confirming Eligibility - Reminder

Reminder: Members are responsible for confirming eligibility for students who intend to register for courses.

The Learning Center will automatically recognize license and age prerequisites; however, members are responsible for confirming that coaches also meet the additional eligibility criteria.

B Course –

- Have three (3) or more years of coaching experience (any level)
- Students must have access to a team playing 11v11(U13+) for the duration of the course

C Course –

• Students must have access to a team playing 11v11(U13+) for the duration of the course


D Course –


• Students must have access to a team (U7-U12) for the duration of the course



D & C Reassessment Reminders

- There is no waiting period from the date of receiving "Provisional Status" before a coach can register for a reassessment.
- Provisional status students are provided with one (1) reassessment opportunity. If the
 reassessment attempt does not meet the evaluation requirements of the course, then the coach will
 not receive the license. They would need to retake the entire D/C course to be eligible to earn the
 license.
- The reassessment window is open for one (1) year following the end date of the course. If a reassessment attempt is not started within a year, then the coach would need to register to take the entire D/C course.
- Students are expected to attend all course meetings with the educator and complete all assignment(s) by due dates
- Students must have access to players and/or team that match the course context for the duration
 of the course with the ability to submit a video of them coaching
- On satisfactory evaluation, students will receive the U.S. Soccer License!
