

## ISL INSTRUCTIONS TO REFEREES FOR MATCH PROCEDURES

#### **Prior to The Game**

- Referees should arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to scheduled kick off time (unless officiating an earlier game on another field).
- Check in Procedures (11U-19/20U Games): Use BOTH the GotSport game card AND player/coach passes (paper and/or virtual).
  - o Each player must have a unique number and players not participating in the game crossed off.
  - o Return player/coach passes to team IMMEDIATELY after check-in. Do **NOT** keep any player/coach passes.
  - o Written in players are **NOT** allowed unless approved by George Perry or his designee.
  - o A MAXIMUM of 4 adults in the bench area at any one time. Coaches/Managers must be on the game card and have their coach/manager pass. Club DOCs are not required to be on game card BUT must have DOC pass.
- Check in Procedures (10U Games): Each team must provide ONE (1) of the following for player/coach check-in:
  - A State Roster Pool list with the players participating that day highlighted or checked.
  - o A copy of the game card with players' name typed on the card.
  - o Player passes/cards, hard and/or virtual copies, may be used.
- First team listed on the match schedule is to wear light/white color jerseys. When there is a conflict in uniform color, the team listed second on the schedule must change its jerseys, except in situations where the team listed first is wearing dark colored jerseys, then the team listed first must change to light/white color jerseys. The referee shall define what constitutes light and dark color jerseys.
- Missing Referees: If one or more referees do not show up for an assigned game, club AR(s) should be used. The referee fees should be paid accordingly to the referee(s) in attendance. The fee(s) for absent referee(s) must be returned to the teams. Club AR(s) are NOT paid.
- Cameras: No cameras are allowed on the team side of the field. Cameras must be set up using weights/tiedowns on spectators' side at least 10-feet from the field near midfield.

# **During The Game**

Game Ball: Provided by one of the competing teams. Be sure to return game ball to team.

8U	10-minute quarters	3
10U	25-minutes halves	4
11U-12U	30-minute halve	4
13U-14U	35-minute halves	5
15U-16U	40-minute halves	5
17U-19/20U	45-minute halves	5
Fall <b>ONLY</b> : 15& Over (7v7) AND 15U (11v11)	35-minute halves	5

<sup>\* 10-</sup>minute halftime (10U-19U)

### **After The Game**

Scan the QR code (or use the GotSport instructions at the bottom of the game card) to input all cards issued. Teams are responsible for entering the score, not referees. The GotSport game card can be given to the winning team or the first team listed in the event of a tie.

Send-offs or serious Incidents are to be reported immediately following the game using the <u>supplemental report form linked here</u> and emailed to George Perry.
