

NATIONAL LEAGUE REFEREES GAME CARD SUMMARY

The National League is operating electronic game cards for the 2025-26 seasonal year through our new software provider, Squadi! Referees **DO NOT** need to download an app or create an account to access game cards or report scores.

REFEREE PROCEDURE OVERVIEW

Electronic Check-In / Scoring Summary

- 1 On your phone/device, **SCAN** the QR code presented by either team OR found on the Game Card. This opens the specific game scoring area on your web browser.
- 2 On your phone/device, **VERIFY** the player attendance list for each team while reviewing the USYS player cards submitted by the team.
- 3 On your phone/device, **SUBMIT** the final score after the game and assign any issued cards to the correct players. Click Submit.
- 4 Once the score is submitted, you can **ACCESS** the live/posted game summary by clicking the game information link on the confirmation page. The link takes you to the game summary, which is always accessible within the league schedule.

Need to submit a USSF Supplemental Report?

USSF Supplemental Reports submission will follow your normal process outlined by your assignor/referee coordinator. These reports are **NOT** submitted in Squadi.

Have a physical game card?

Paper game cards might be presented by teams or league officials as back-up, the primary means of team check-in and scoring will be electronic. *Scan the QR code on the game card to initiate the electronic process.* If a paper copy must be utilized, take a picture of the completed game card (for your records) and return the game card to the home team.
