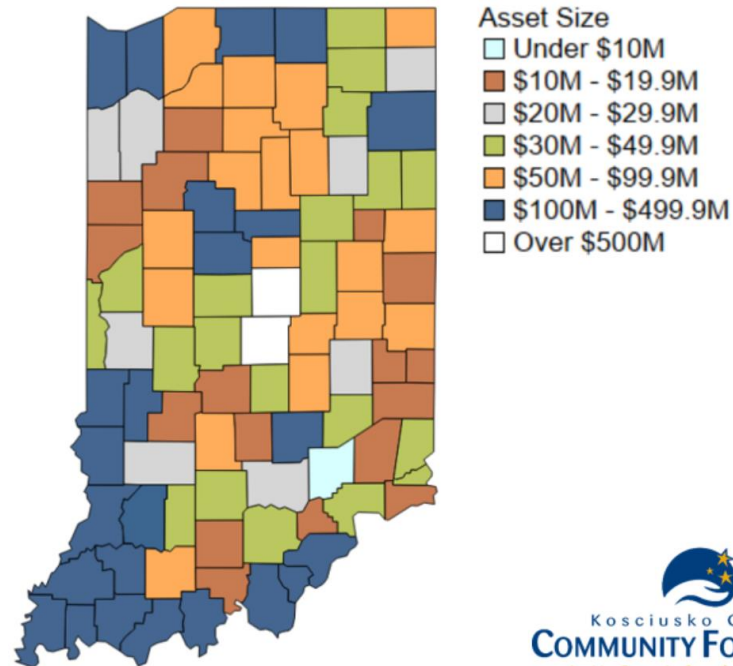
Scope of Indiana CFs

Every county in Indiana is supported by a Community Foundation* (CF):

- 76 total CFs, more than any other state! (IN represents ~8% of all CFs in the U.S.)
- Total Assets: \$6.03B
- Total Grants: \$306.5M
- 500+ individuals employed by the field in Indiana

Purpose & Role

CFs approach their work in a **blend** of the following ways to serve their county*:

- **Asset building:**
 - Develop relationships with donors
 - Invest and protect the principal of endowed gifts
 - Distribute grants based on the charitable intent of the donor
- **Broad, flexible grantmaking:**
 - Understand community needs
 - Re-direct charitable dollars as community needs change
 - Proactive or responsive
- **Community leader**

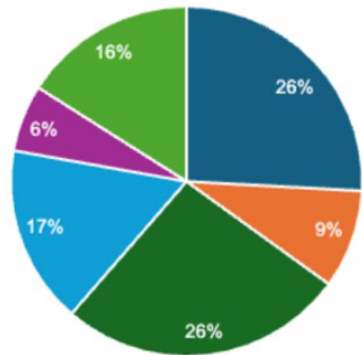

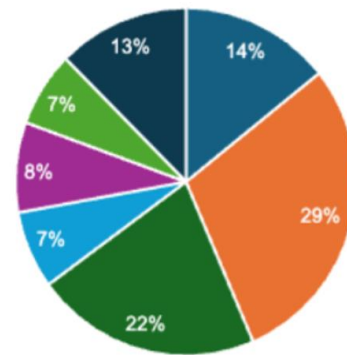

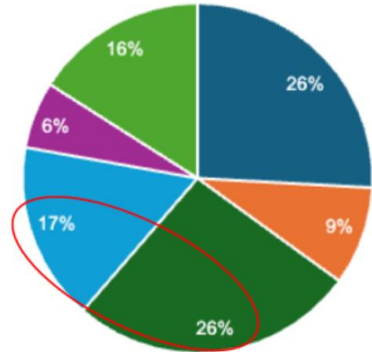

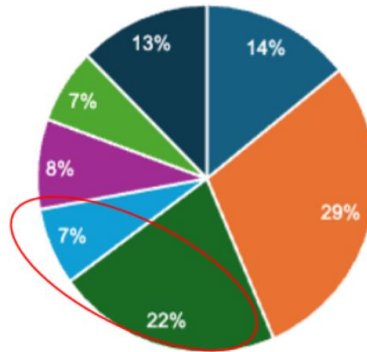
Number of Funds Held at Community Foundations
