

Todd Sheely is currently in his 21st year with the Indiana Olympic Development Program (ODP), where he has worked with multiple age groups and both genders throughout his tenure. He is entering his eighth year as Indiana's ODP/Indiana Development Program (IDP) Director.

Coach Sheely has spent 24 years coaching high school soccer in Indiana, including his 23rd year as a head coach. He served as the head girls coach for 10 years and the head boys coach for two years at Center Grove High School. Currently, Sheely serves as the boys head soccer coach at Elkhart High School. During his 22 years as a head coach, his teams have won 13 sectional championships, 10 regional championships, and advanced to seven Elite Eight appearances and two Final Four appearances. He was named the Indiana High School Girls Soccer Coach of the Year in 2007.

In addition to his high school and ODP experience, Coach Sheely has accumulated 17 years of club coaching experience throughout Indianapolis and Northern Indiana.

Beyond coaching, Sheely is an educator at Elkhart High School. His excellence in the classroom has earned him Teacher of the Year honors at both Center Grove High School (2009) and Elkhart High School (2019).

A 1997 graduate of Center Grove High School, Sheely earned his degree from IUPUI in 2001. As a student-athlete, he was a starter on the IUPUI team that won a conference championship and qualified for the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2000. In recognition of their accomplishments, Sheely and his teammates were inducted into the IUPUI Athletics Hall of Fame in 2017.

Todd is the proud father of three children: sons Mayson and Brennan, and daughter Morgan.

Coach Sheely holds a US Youth Soccer National Youth License, an NSCAA Premier Diploma, and a USSF "B" License. He has served as a Midwest Region ODP Head Coach for various age groups over the past seven years and was selected as the U.S. Youth Soccer ODP National Team Coach for the 2009 Boys in 2023.

In March of 2026, Coach Sheely was named the Chief Operating Officer of Indiana Soccer.
